About the Organization

The Florida Children's Council (Council) is a non-profit organization that serves as the state association for the Children's Services Councils (CSCs) which are local dedicated funding streams created by the voters of a county for the sole purpose of helping children in accordance with priorities defined by the community. By engaging and enhancing the collective strengths of individual Children's Services Councils, the Council promotes statewide policies that build effective prevention and early intervention systems of supports for Florida's children and families. With intentional focus on collective impact and evidenced-based strategies, the Council coordinates resource and system development activities to enhance Florida's collective efforts to ensure children are healthy and prepared for school and a successful future. The Council supports and compliments the work of community Children's Services Councils by promoting data sharing among the individual CSCs and focusing on state-level system development strategies prenatal to career with recognition that more effective State systems and policies increase the abilities of communities to maximize resources and make strategic investments to support better outcomes for children, youth, and families. Additionally, the Council works with and provides assistance to Florida counties that are exploring the CSC model for their community.

Job Purpose

The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) reports directly to the Board of Directors. The CEO is responsible for the day to day operations and overall program and personnel management of the Children's Services Council of Florida, Inc. (501-c-4) and the Florida Children's Services Council, Inc. (501-c-3), which are the two entities that comprise the Florida Children's Council.

A successful candidate will possess the qualifications and skills necessary to work effectively with the Council Board of Director's and provide leadership on the administration, member development, and strategic plan of the Council, as well as have a demonstrated track record of success in leadership, management, resource and policy development. The ideal candidate will have experience working with a Board of Directors, strong working knowledge of statewide systems of care across domains that affect Florida's children and youth; proven talent for strategic visionary thinking through a disciplined, analytic lens; the ability to work cooperatively with thought leaders, elected officials, agency representatives, child advocates, business leaders, and others who influence the health and well-being of Florida's children, youth and their families; and be able to identify and execute opportunities for grant development to increase the sustainable impact of the Council.

Travel

Travel is expected for this position. Travel will include Florida communities and occasional national meetings. If the candidate is located outside of Leon County travel will be more frequent to Tallahassee during legislative session. Requires working occasional weekends and weeknights.
